### BOUNCE

on over to your local dealership for a quick vehicle inspection.

Your dealer can also check to see if there are **any open recalls** for your vehicle. In fact, **84 percent** of vehicles inspected at community car care events nationwide last year needed service or parts.



### BOOGIE

down the road on safe tires.

Be sure your tires **are properly inflated**. The correct PSI (found in owner's manual or driver's side door sticker) not only **improves tire safety** but can also **improve gas mileage up to 3 percent** saving you a few bucks.



### BUILD

an emergency kit.



Include a **cell phone charger, bottled water, nonperishable food, first aid kit, flashlight, flares, white flag, maps, paper towels, and basic repair tools** (including duct tape, jumper cables, work gloves).



### BUCKLE

your young children in correctly installed car seats.
